COMMERCIAL PILOT LICENSE (CPL) PROGRAM

Admission & Eligibility Criteria

- **Academic Credentials:** Completion of 10+2 with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics and Mathematics.
- **Medical Assessments:**
 - Active Class II Medical Certification (Indian) required at joining.

Flight Training Curriculum

The curriculum is strictly engineered to deliver precision command of both single and multi-engine platforms:

- **Single-Engine Flight Maneuvers:** 185 Hours
- **Multi-Engine & Instrument Rating (IR):** 15 Hours

◦ Class I Medical Certification is mandatory for the formal issuance of the CPL license.

▪ **Total Flight Allocation: 200 Hours**

- **Age Requirement:** Minimum of 21 years of age at the time of program commencement.
- **Theoretical Benchmarks:** Candidate must have successfully cleared a minimum of three (3) DGCA flight crew examinations.
- **Linguistic Proficiency:** Adequate operational fluency and command of the English language.

TUITION FEES & STRUCTURED INVESTMENT SCHEDULE

The total baseline program package is valued at **INR 54,00,000** (*subject to market-variable adjustments*). Payments are structured across operational milestones as detailed below:

Voluntary Withdrawal Policy: Any voluntary cancellation, withdrawal, or transfer initiated by the candidate will incur a mandatory **40% administrative deduction** from all previously deposited installments.

TERMS, CONDITIONS & INSTITUTIONAL POLICIES

1. Financial Compliance & Late Penalties

The initial registration fee of Rs. 2,00,000 is entirely non-refundable. Documentation and transfer processing with the current FTO will commence solely upon receipt of payment and validation of a transaction snapshot. All Bharat Kosh payments must be handled, executed, and settled individually by the candidate.

Flight training and simulator operations will be suspended immediately if an account falls into arrears due to partial, delayed, or missed installments. In the event of non-payment or delayed compliance, Gujarat Flying Club reserves the right to claim the entire outstanding balance along with interest at **18% per annum, compounded quarterly**.

2. Mandatory Residential Policy

To maintain operational synergy, safety, and discipline, all cadets are strictly required to reside in the academy-provided hostel facility located adjacent to the airfield. Accommodation is billed at **Rs. 20,000 per month**, encompassing climate-controlled (AC) housing and three balanced daily meals. The initial lodging outlay requires a 3-month advance payment structure upon joining (comprising a 2-month security deposit and 1 month's current rent).

3. Price Protection & Training Extensions

The provided package is strictly valid for a period of 15 days from the date of issuance and covers only the explicitly mentioned inclusions. Base rates are guaranteed for 15 to 18 months from the formal date of enrollment. The overall package is subject to a structured revision following the completion of the 20-month mark.

Program duration is heavily contingent upon individual student aptitudes, academic milestones, examination clearances (DGCA/RTR), as well as meteorological conditions or natural calamities. If training extends beyond 18 months due to performance deficits or external delays, GFC shall not be held responsible for original cost retention; the candidate will be billed at an increased per-hour rate adjusted for prevailing aviation fuel prices.
